CONFERENCE PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

Until 1 October 2024 to the email address of the conference organising committee kafedra_pip@bk.ru it is necessary to send an application for participation and an article designed according to the requirements below. The subject of the email is indicated as "*Dominants of psychological and pedagogical excellence in physical education and sport*".

Upon receipt of the application and article, the organising committee will confirm their acceptance by email **within three working days**.

Materials of articles that do not correspond to the topic, design requirements or have text originality of less than 60% **will not be accepted for publication and will not be returned**.

PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Relevance, scientific, theoretical and practical novelty, as well as the absence of information of extremist, defamatory and inflammatory nature.
- The limit on the possible number of articles by one author: up to one article individually and two articles co-authored.
- The author, sending the manuscript to the Editorial Board, takes personal responsibility for the originality of the research. Materials with more than 40% of plagiarism or self-plagiarism will not be accepted.
- An important criterion of copyright compliance is the author's reference to the sources of information when writing the article. The Conference Organising Committee reserves the right to edit the article.

ARTICLE GUIDELINES

- The structure of the article (**obligatory!**) should include: title, abstract (no more than 50 words), keywords (no more than 5) in Russian and English, text of the article, list of references.
 - The volume of the article is 3-8 pages.
 - Text format: Word text editor; A4 format; Times New Roman font; font size 14 pt; single spacing; first line indent - 1.25 cm; margins: top, bottom, right, left - 2 cm.
 - The text of the article should contain an introduction (relevance), the purpose of the study, research methods, research results and their discussion, conclusions and a list of references (if available). The text may include graphic images and tables (not more than three), for which it is necessary to indicate their location in the article by references, for example: Fig. 1, Fig. 2, Table 1. Files of images and tables in pdf, jpg, phg, tif formats should be attached to the application form and the article material.
 - The main text is followed by a list of references in alphabetical order in accordance with GOST R 7.0.100-2018. References to sources are made out in square brackets corresponding to the number of the author in the bibliographic list. Font size – 12 pt.
 - The title of the article is printed in capital letters in the centre without hyphenation. Below, the author's full name (in full), academic degree, title, position. On the next line the full name of the educational institution, the name of the city, followed by the text of the article.
