On behalf of the International Association of Universities of Physical Education and Sport, we invite students, undergraduates, graduate students, doctoral students of your university to take part in the **XI International Scientific Conference of Students and Young Scientists “UNIVERSITY SPORTS: HEALTH AND PROSPERITY OF THE NATION”**, which will be held **on September 23-24, 2022** on the basis of the Uzbek State University of Physical Education and Sport.

Purpose of the Conference:

Consolidation of young scientists and specialists to discuss various problems and prospects for the development of university sports, means and methods for promoting the health and physical development of young people.

To participate in the conference are invited:

Members of the International University Sports Federation (FISU); Young scientists not older than 35 years at the time of the conference: students, undergraduates, graduate students and doctoral students, teachers, researchers and specialists in physical education and sports.

Directions of the conference:

1. Student sports movement: experience, problems, prospects.
2. Innovative technologies of the modern system of training athletes.
3. Motor activity and mass sports in a healthy lifestyle. Sports and health tourism.
4. Medico-biological and psychological support of student sports.
5. Physical education in educational institutions of all types: problems and prospects.

Conference working languages:

Russian, English, Uzbek.

Plenary and breakout sessions, poster sessions.

Hybrid format (face-to-face participation and Internet).

Based on the results of the conference, a collection of materials will be published with the assignment of the ISBN identifier, which in PDF format will be posted on the university's Internet page, in international databases for indexing scientific citation, and will also be sent along with the participant's certificate to the e-mail address indicated in the application.

Duration of reports:

- plenary session - 20-25 minutes
- breakout session - 10-15 minutes
- poster (poster) report - 5 minutes

Conditions for participation in the conference:

To participate in the conference **until June 30, 2022**, it is necessary to send to the organizing committee by e-mail: conference2022@jtsu.uz the following files, issued separately in the format: "Ibragimov Thesis.doc," "Ibragimov Application.doc" and "Ibragimov Data.doc":

1) **Application for participation** in the conference (*Appendix 1*), filled in for each participant separately.

2) **Text of scientific work** in .doc format, drawn up in accordance with the requirements (*Appendices 2.1 and 2.2*). From one author (including co-authorship) *no more than 2 abstracts are accepted*.

3) **Certificate of educational status** indicating the course of study for students (bachelors) and masters.

4) After the acceptance of the materials, each participant will be sent **bank details to pay the registration fee**. A copy of the bank transfer receipt marked "UzSUPhES-2022 Conference" must be sent to the organizers' e-mail. In case of payment of the registration fee during the conference it is necessary to provide a *letter of guarantee* about the upcoming payment on the official form of the sending organization

REQUIREMENTS FOR FORMING MATERIALS:

- The topics of the abstracts should correspond to the topics of the conference directions.
- The abstracts of the report should briefly present the results of the conducted scientific research or detailed analytical scientific material.
- Materials are provided in the amount of **up to 3 pages of A4 format**, do not number the pages.
- The text of the abstracts is drawn up in the text editor MS Word, font – Times New Roman, size – 14, line spacing – single, text alignment – In width, margins – 2 cm on each side.
- The text of the work should not contain word hyphenation.
- Information from the 1st to the 6th line is given *in English and Russian*.
 - 1st line: UDC index reflecting the subject of the work.
 - 2nd line: the title of the work in the center in capital letters, in bold.
 - 3rd line: First name Last name (in full) of all authors in lower case, bold italics.
 - 4th line: full name of the organization, country, city.
 - 5th line: e-mail address (e-mail) of one of the authors.
 - 6th line: keywords, no more than 2 lines.
 - 7th line: annotation, not more than 500 characters with spaces.
- If the work is written *in English*, then the title, abstract (4-5 lines) and keywords should be presented in Russian.
- Through the interval - the text of the scientific work.
- Abstracts must be *structured*:
 - Introduction (relevance)* indicating the problem, analysis of recent research and publications on the research topic, highlighting previously unresolved parts of the problem that this work is devoted to;
 - Purpose and objectives of this work*;
 - Methods and organization of research*;
 - The results of the study and their discussion* with a full justification of the obtained scientific results (with a show of what has been established and clarified);
 - conclusions* with the prospect of further research in this direction;
 - Bibliography*, formatted according to the standard in the original language, no more than 5 sources in alphabetical order, indicated in the text in square brackets [1, 2].
- Manuscripts of scientific articles are checked by the Anti-Plagiarism system. The share of the original text should be **at least 60%**.
- The author is solely responsible for the content of the materials.
- Students and undergraduates present their work with the approval of the supervisor.
- Works designed and sent without meeting the specified requirements, sent after the deadline, will not be accepted for printing.
